PaperStone: a heavy duty solid surface known for its warm neutral appearance resembling the natural beauty of stone, its contemporary appearance and its environmental sustainability.

PaperStone Guidelines:

- When preparing food always use a cutting board.
- Recommend use of hot pads or trivets under hot pans.
- Avoid harsh chemicals when cleaning.
- General cleaning consists of wiping down surface with PaperStone Cleaner & Rejuvenator or a PH neutral cleaner on an as-needed basis.
- Avoid letting spills with high alkaline base sit for long periods of time.

Routine Cleaning and Upkeep:

PaperStone's surface beauty and extreme durability is designed to last a lifetime whether it is in your kitchen, bath or office. A simple routine maintenance will preserve the natural beauty. Keep surface wiped down with PaperStone Cleaner & Rejuvenator. This will maintain the sheen and luster of surface appearance.

Surface Treatment:

Treat surface with recommended PaperStone Sealer. Use a lint free cloth (old t-shirts work well), apply a thin coat of PaperStone Sealer to entire surface. One 12 oz. bottle covers (120-150 SF). Let finish set for a minimum of twenty minutes, then wipe and buff off excess with a clean cloth.

For ongoing maintenance, **repeat every 6-12 months**. This will maintain

1	the overall beauty and patina while enhancing luster and sheen.	
ı	Removing Surface Scratches and Stains:	
 	To remove stains and light surface scratches, first try the Cleaner/ Rejuvenator. If stain or scratch still persists gently use a red scotch brite pad and buff area desired. A random orbital sander may be necessary for removal of stains and scratches. Use 220 grit or above sand paper. Excessive sanding or buffing in the same area may create an inconsistent appearance. When sanding, less is more. Follow with Paperstone Sealer, (less is more) on entire surface for sheen consistence.
